Local Government Strategic Planning



LODA holds key responsibilities in the **public investment process** on the local government level and, therefore, serves as the technical secretariat for the **Local Government Projects Advisory Committee**. LODA also monitors **execution of public investments** undertaken through Districts.






OUR MANDATE


LODA is tasked with:

- Providing guidance for **proper planning** of LED/LG infrastructure projects along the infrastructure lifecycle
- Assisting LG in **Annual Planning and Budgeting Process** (BCC 1 and BCC 2)
- Support LG in **infrastructure development**
- Monitoring **LG infrastructure lifecycle** management from planning to maintenance
- **Monitoring outcomes** of existing infrastructure as related to improved service delivery

OUR MANDATE

LODA is mandated to play a key role in **establishing local participatory mechanisms** to eradicate extreme poverty and reduce moderate poverty. This is done in many ways, namely establishing strategies for **creation of high intensive labor and assistance** to those unable to perform such jobs and contributing to the **sensitization of the population to participate** in development activities meant for them.

In collaboration with decentralized entities and various development partners, LODA has been gradually implementing the **Vision Umurenge Programme (VUP)** through three major components: the **Safety Net Component** (comprised of Direct Support, Classic Public Works, Expanded Public Works, and Nutrition-Sensitive Direct Support), the **Livelihood Development Component** (composed of Asset Transfers, Skills Development, and Financial Services), and the **Sensitization and Community Mobilization Component**.
